

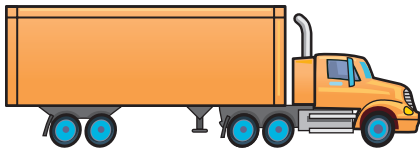

Draw a line to match each object to its weight.



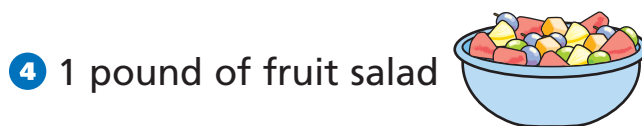
