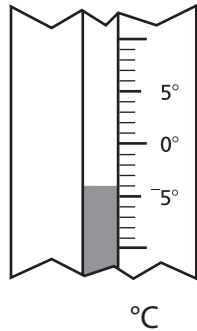

 B. -3°C D. -5°C

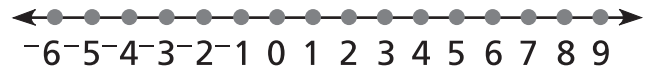
- 2 If the temperature drops 3° , what will the thermometer show?
