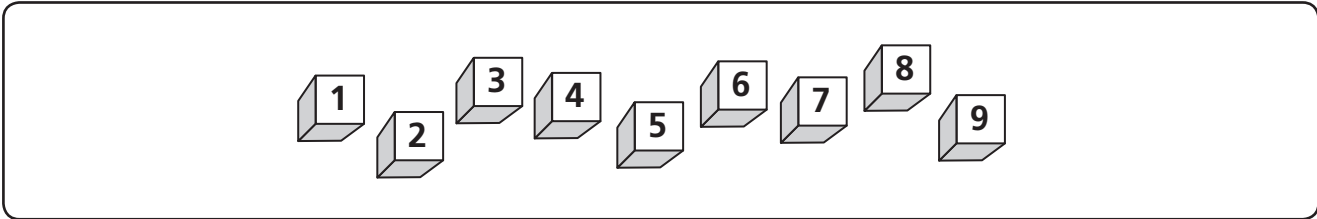
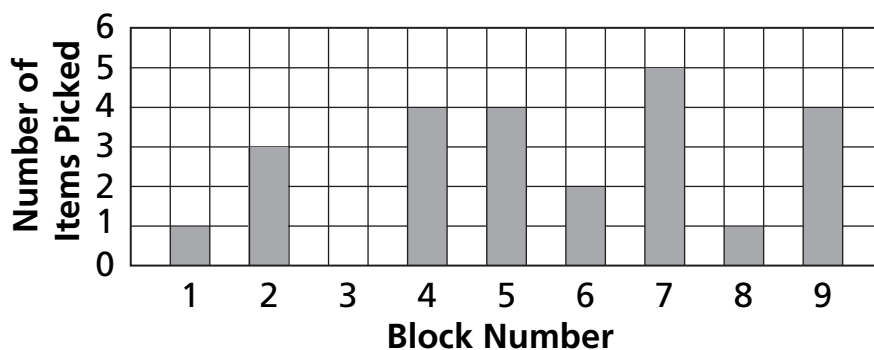


# Drawing Blocks
